All Saints Academy is a Catholic Elementary school that serves students in PreSchool through 8th grade. We have been here at Christ the King Campus since 2004.

Christ the King is a long-standing parish and provided Catholic education to the families on the East Side of Columbus since the 1950's. The parish has a long standing tradition of quality education and community programs that have served many over the years. Many students came through Christ the King Elementary school during the 50's, 60's, 70's, 80's and 90's.

In 2004 the Diocese of Columbus combined three schools, St. Thomas, St. Philip, and Christ the King. Thus All Saints Academy began. The school continued through the years providing quality education to a diverse population and working to meet the needs of the families in and around the parish. The mission has always been to provide quality education and prepare the students to be contributing members focusing on service, and love for Jesus and his teachings.

The population of All Saints Academy has been transformed to be what it is today, a vibrant community of people from various backgrounds all coming together to spread the Good News and to love Jesus. We have been growing in enrollment and have seen an increase of more than 40% since 2009.

Today we continue to be a much needed part of the East Side of Columbus and draw students from many backgrounds, economic needs, and zip codes. We offer many services to our students and work with the parish to be the hands and feet of Jesus to those we meet.
